India and Saudi Arabia enjoy multifaceted relations reflecting the centuries old economic and socio-cultural ties. India and Saudi Arabia are old business partners; their trade relations go back several centuries in time. Today, the bilateral business ties are being steadily expanded and further strengthened by continuous interaction and cooperation, including regular exchange of business delegations. Besides being a major trade partner, India sees the Kingdom as a major pillar for its energy security and an important economic partner for investments, joint ventures, transfer of technology projects.

The value of India Saudi Arabia bilateral trade during 2015-16 decreased to USD 26.71 billion, a 31.98% fall from USD 39.27 billion last year, as per figures provided by the Directorate General of Foreign Trade. The decline may be attributed mainly to low petroleum and commodity prices and lower global demand. During this period, our imports from Saudi Arabia reached USD 20.31 billion, registering a decline of 22.42% over previous year (USD 28.11 billion) whereas our exports to Saudi Arabia reached USD 6.40 billion registering a decline of 8.61% over previous year (USD 11.16 billion).
