India's exports to Bangladesh in the H1 of 2015-16 (July-December 2015) are US\$ 2684.10 million and the imports from Bangladesh during the same period were US\$ 321.09 million. Over the last five years (since FY 2010-11), total trade between the two countries have risen by 24.3%.
